

## **Filippo Papa Artist**

**Date of birth October 24, 1986 | Italian Nationality**



### **Biography**

Filippo Papa, born in Leonforte (Italy) on October 24, 1986, is an artist known for his eclecticism, embracing various forms of art such as photography, performance, graphic design, video art, installations, painting, and writing, and he is also active in cultural promotion. He graduated with honors from the Master's program in Graphic Design at the Academy of Fine Arts in Catania, where he also served as a Lecturer in graphic design subjects. He has taught Art History at a private educational institute.

His career is marked by a constant commitment to taking his art beyond geographical and cultural boundaries, with solo exhibitions that have made a significant impact internationally.

Among his most important exhibitions are "Treanime" in 2012, "Archai" in 2016, "Il Canto della Pietra" in 2017, "Aqua" in 2018, "Contrasto & Contesto" in 2019, "Pathos/Mathos" in 2021, "Omniscient" in 2022, and "Collateral Visions" in 2024. Each exhibition represents a fundamental chapter in his journey, highlighting a continuous stylistic evolution that blends tradition and innovation. Papa has received numerous international awards, recognitions, and publications. In 2012, one of his photographs was selected globally by Vogue's website, and in 2014 and 2016, his works were featured on the Rai 3 program "Tgr Mediterraneo," broadcast in Italy and abroad. Between 2020 and 2021, he was included in the Contemporary Art Atlas published by De Agostini and in the prestigious "56th Catalog of Modern Art" by Giorgio Mondadori.

In 2022, Papa celebrated 10 years of his career with the publication of the book "Omniscient," in collaboration with Joan Josep Barcelo, and won the "Italy Photography Award" at the International Art Biennale of Asti. That same year, he received the "High Merit Award for Performing Arts" for his innovative "Skin Collage" technique and, together with Barcelo, created "Performance Art & Poetry," which culminated in the "Poetry Box" performance. They also introduced the "Holoperformance" concept with "Regeneration," presented at the Amedeo Modigliani Foundation in Venice.

In 2023, he performed the world's first live artistic performance in the Metaverse with "Eros Captivity," coining the term "Metaperformance." This achievement earned him first place in the Professional Photography - Abstract Architecture category at the "International Photography Awards" in New York, with his work published in the IPA Book 2023.

Also in 2023, he published the book "Arcorporea" with Joan Josep Barcelo, which won first prize at the "Giglio Blu" competition in Florence.

In 2024, Filippo Papa received the International Excellence Award for Performing Arts from the Cygnus Aureus International Literary Arts Prize and an Honorable Mention at the International Photography Awards for his project "Arcspacetime." Additionally, he was honored with an important recognition from the Regional Council of Tuscany for his excellence in the arts, awarded as part of the Sandomenichino Literary Prize. In the same year, he presented his new solo exhibition "Collateral Visions" in Spain, further solidifying his presence on the international art scene.
